Color Definitions:
Hue: Another name for color.
Primary Colors: **Red**, **yellow** and **blue**:
not be mixed from any other colors.

Secondary Colors:
Two primary colors mixed together.

yellow + blue = green	blue + red = violet	red + yellow = orange
-----------------------	---------------------	-----------------------

Warm Colors: Reds, oranges and yellows.

Intermediate Colors: One primary and one secondary color mixed together.

red + orange = red-orange	orange + yellow = yellow-orange	yellow + green = yellow-green	green + blue = blue-green	blue + violet = blue-violet	violet + red = red-violet
